2022 HVAC RENOVATION PROJECT

The final phase of upgrading and modernizing the District's entire HVAC system is underway! The work for this project is taking place in the 1956 and 1966 Building Sections. The project includes removing the noisy, inefficient, and troublesome single air handling units and replacing them with a modern, efficient, and centralized system. Also, the two boilers in the 1956 Section have been replaced that service these building sections. In addition to improved air quality in these sections, our entire HVAC system for our facility will become manageable via our online program, which will assist with efficiency and troubleshooting. The project officially began on April 11, 2022, and is on target for completion before the start of the 2022-2023 school year!
