Board Member Qualifications

- A School Board member must be, on the date of election or appointment, a United States citizen, at least 18 years of age, a resident of Illinois and the District for at least one year immediately preceding the election, and a registered voter.
- Reasons making an individual ineligible for Board membership include holding an incompatible office and certain types of State or federal employment. A child sex offender, as defined in State law, is ineligible for School Board membership.

Major Activities of a Board Member

- Complete IASB required training activities
- Complete New Board Member Orientation with Superintendent
- Represent the District and Community
- Hire /employ/evaluate Superintendent
- Promote and update District's Mission and Vision
- Strategic planning/leadership
- Provide financial oversight/leadership
- Update, review, and adopt policy
- Read and stay current with current District information/news provided by Superintendent
- Review monthly meeting agenda items and information
- Attend monthly meetings and certain committee meetings
- Vote on meeting action items that are provided with recommendations from Superintendent
